Make a Movie. Produce a TV Show. Create Dynamic Graphics. Lindenwood University in St. Charles, Missouri, is sponsoring a Summer Film and TV Camp for high school students for the second year.

Students can learn filmmaking and TV production skills from the award-winning faculty, who have years of experience making Hollywood films, network TV, local newscasts, and documentaries.

Assistant Professor in Communications Jill Falk was a morning anchor in Lansing, Michigan, before she came to Lindenwood. She is now the News Director for LUTV, the university's station.

Ben Scholle, the Department Chair for the new Digital Cinema Arts program, is a Webster Groves High School and Washington University graduate and was a professional editor in Dallas, Texas, and he has numerous awards for his documentaries.

LUTV Director of Operations and Assistant Professor Ed Voss worked at Fox in production and operations before he came to Lindenwood. He teaches classes and produces news and programming in the all-HD studio, as well as on location.

Peter Carlos, Station Manager and Associate Professor in the Digital Cinema Arts program, worked for a number of years as a freelance film and television producer, director, writer, as well as multimedia producer. He worked for a time in Hollywood with the likes of Jim Carrey and Kirsten Dunst.

Students will use Lindenwood 's high-definition TV studio and digital cinema equipment to produce professional quality movies and television programs.

“The camp is perfect for future directors, editors, and on-camera talent, whether they have experience behind the camera or just getting started,” says Carlos, who also programs the station. “We believe that a hands-on approach works best for our students.”

The university’s channel, LUTV is on Charter Communications in St. Charles County, AT&T’s UVerse is St. Charles and St. Louis-wide, and streams live on Lindenwood’s web site, www.lindenwood.edu.

There are two sessions—June 14th to June 18th and June 21th to June 25th. Students can sign up for either sessions, but there is limited space. The camp begins at 9am and runs until 4pm daily, with a lunch in between. Students will receive a DVD of their movies and TV program, free screening of their work for friends and family, a t-shirt, and lunch for \$135 for the week.
